The representative sample of 1000 respondents were collected by CAPI (Computer-Assisted Personal Interviewing) in the capital Ulan Bator and Arkhangay, Govi-Altay, Dornogovi, Dornod, Uvurkhangay, Selenge and Uvs aymags (split proportionally by 4 regional divisions and capital Ulaanbaatar).
