



### POLITBAROMETER #23(57), May 2024

The "Sant Maral" Foundation presents the results of the survey, conducted from April 23 to May 19, 2024. The representative sample of 1000 respondents were collected by CAPI (Computer-Assisted Personal Interviewing) in the capital Ulan Bator and Arkhangay, Govi-Altay, Dornogovi, Dornod, Uvurkhangay, Selenge and Uvs aymags (split proportionally by 4 regional divisions and capital Ulaanbaatar).

In the data below, tabulations are sorted by "capital," "countryside," and "nationwide" when relevant.
